The collaboration of **Richard Dillon** and **Corinne Seganos** offers up nine warm and wonderful Christmas songs to delight every heart on **We Follow the Star**. Corinne's voice is soft and appealing while Richard's orchestrations are emotional and sophisticated. They begin appropriately with one of the oldest carols on record, the Irish song **Wexford Carol**. Corinne renders the lyrics like Christmas poetry. With a howling wind, a flurry of notes, and tinkle of tiny bells, **A Winter's Night** becomes one of many productions on the album that could open any Broadway show. I liked this one because it reminded me of one of my favorite sub-genres, winter music, where you can feel the cold wind at your back while stars twinkle in the heavens. The title tune, **We Follow the Star**, is a major orchestral performance that is way too short for me. I can envision this being the nexus for a beautiful symphony. Dillon's composition suggests that a solitary light shining above all else not only in the sky, but in your heart. What magic is this? Seganos does a remarkable job on the most popular Christmas carol ever, **Silent Night**. Her reverence and clarity are quite touching. This is a warm, inviting album for the season. It is so well accomplished that I immediately made a Christmas wish for more. Highly recommended.
